Desirable (but not essential): previous experience working with children and/or children/young people/adults with disabilities.

- Delivering personalised support in a group setting by assisting participants with skills building activities, personal care and manual handling.
- Supporting participants in making their own choices and building skills to be more independent.
- Supporting participants to engage and participate in their community during such activities as shopping and catching public transport.
- Building positive relationships with the participants.
- Transporting clients, if applicable
