Edu. Change was established in September 2022 to support students with disabilities leaving school with transitioning into the community and higher education. Our post school skills building program focuses on a series of life and tertiary education skills including shopping, using money, cooking, reading and writing recipes.

The program runs every Friday (other than public holidays) 9am-2pm. This role would be expected to work 8:30am to 3pm.

We are looking for someone who has:

- Previous experience in working in an educational setting (i.e. early childhood, primary, secondary, tertiary).
- Has experience working with children/young people/adults with disabilities and have an understanding of behaviour management strategies.
- Holds a Working With Children Check (NSW) or is willing obtain it
- Meet the vaccination requirements for working within disability settings (3 doses)
- A full driving licence

Your responsibilities:

- Overseeing the delivery of the Eds. Change kitchen sessions - this includes directing support workers, managing the young people's learning and ensuring the safety of all participants.
- Ensuring all participants' learning folders are set up correctly and ready for them to use at the beginning of the day.
- Complete session planning within paid hours.
- Driving the participants and workers to community settings or facilitating the use of public transport.
- Supervising the young people and workers whilst food shopping.
- Leading the morning briefing.
- Managing the young people's behaviour and promoting communication skills through modelling best practice.
- Corresponding with parents where needed and writing up the weekly newsletter.

What we can offer:

- Flexibility - annual leave and sick pay will be available
- The possibility of an additional day's work commencing from January 2024
- A full induction and ongoing mentoring will be provided by the Director of Education
- Ongoing experience from experienced teachers working in the disability space
- Paid training courses
